This leaflet explains how BTCV Scotland can support your group to achieve positive environmental change throughout our towns, cities and countryside.

Membership of Community Network Scotland is open to all groups who want to work for a better environment, whether your group is newly formed or well established. We've been hard at work creating a range of accessible services, discounts and benefits which we hope will help your group achieve its aims.

Community Network Scotland services have been developed in association with Forum for Environmental Volunteering Activity (FEVA) and are currently supported by the Environmental Leaders Development Project.

Community Network Scotland is aimed at both 'traditional' conservation groups and also organisations representing the wider spectrum of community and voluntary activity, including BME groups, mental health organisations, youth groups and others whose members, clients and volunteers can also contribute to, and benefit from, environmental activities.



Community Network Scotland Plus

Membership benefits include:

Access to Insurance at a competitive rate including public liability, volunteers, employees, tools and equipment. The public liability policy is offered in partnership with Zurich Municipal. Grant Funding Assistance Free access to GRANTnet, the UK's biggest funding database which allows community and voluntary groups to select from a wide range of funding opportunities from across the UK and EU.

Community Hub The Community Hub is an online resource, enabling groups to keep a membership database, record details of their work and the sites that they improve. The Hub contains the Resource Bank which contains task report templates, publicity resources, plus health and safety information.

Chestnut Fund The Chestnut Fund is an independent charity administered by BTCV. Groups have access to grants of up to £500 (subject to eligibility) for conservation projects.

Discounts BTCV offers a huge range of discounts to Community Network groups: 10% discount on purchases of tools, wildflowers, and conservation publications.

Website Template BTCV can provide guidance and support to set up your own website. A great service for groups without expertise or who may benefit from being associated with BTCV online.

Network News A quarterly UK-wide newsletter and dedicated web page to keep you up-to-date with new grants, opportunities and news.

Online Groups Directory Free, optional listing in our online directory. This allows volunteers, clients, the media and other groups to contact you easily.

Community Network Scotland Standard

Community Network Scotland Standard has been developed by BTCV Scotland in partnership with FEVA and offers the following benefits as a free stand-alone package for Scottish groups who do not require the Community Network Scotland Plus services but who can still benefit from the learning opportunities, information sharing, events and networking opportunities provided.

Membership benefits include:

Access to the Environmental & Community Leaders Training Programme which provides free or discounted training events. Where course fees apply participants' costs may be met through Individual Learning Accounts (ILAs) subject to eligibility.

Monthly E-bulletin provides up-to-date information on training courses, member events, conferences and campaigns.

Access to the FEVA website for shared information, policies and procedures concerning environmental volunteering. (www.feva-scotland.org)

BTCV Scotland Funding E-newsletter produced three times annually with latest information on funding sources for community environmental projects.

Network Bulletin Full colour publication issued three times annually featuring Scottish Network member groups and volunteers plus news of BTCV Scotland projects and programmes. The Bulletin is available in both printed and online versions.
